CEILING FAN MODEL : 719/3B & 719/5B

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Safety Precaution

IMPORTANT : PLEASE READ BEFORE INSTALLATION

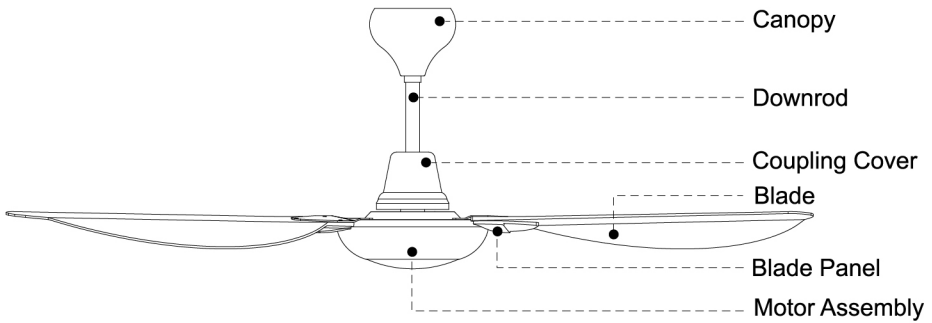
1. Installation must be carried out by a qualified wiring installer.
2. Turn off the electrical mains at the circuit breaker fuse box.
3. Do not use power supply other than 240V 50Hz.
4. The appliance must be permanently connected to the electricity supply through a double pole switch having a contact separation of at least 3mm in all poles.
5. Do not connect ceiling fan to any dimmer switch or regulator.
6. When mounting the fan, ensure that the safety wire is loop across the ceiling mounting hook.
7. The ceiling mounting hook must be able to withhold a min. of 35 pounds.
8. The ceiling fan must be mounted at a min. height of 8.2 feet / 2.5m of clearance from the floor and 3 feet / 1m from the wall to the blade.
9. Do not install at areas/places near/at
 - a) chemicals and alkali
 - b) flammable area such as gas cooker
 - c) oily places
 - d) wet and high humidity area such as shower room
 - e) high vibration/impact and continuously expose to direct wind
10. Do not place any objects in the path of the blades.
11. When all electrical connections are done, store all wires neatly.
12. Make sure that all screws and connection are tighten till snug.



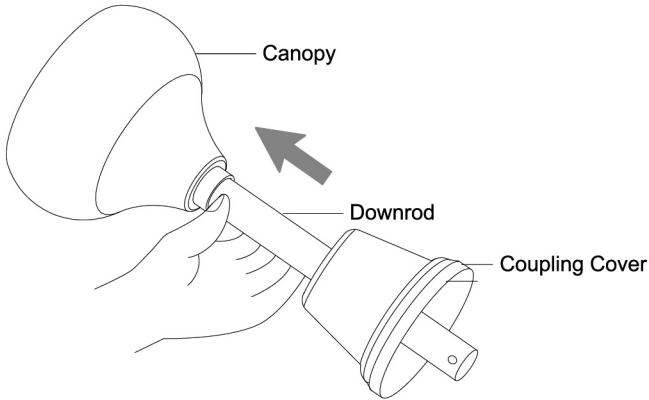

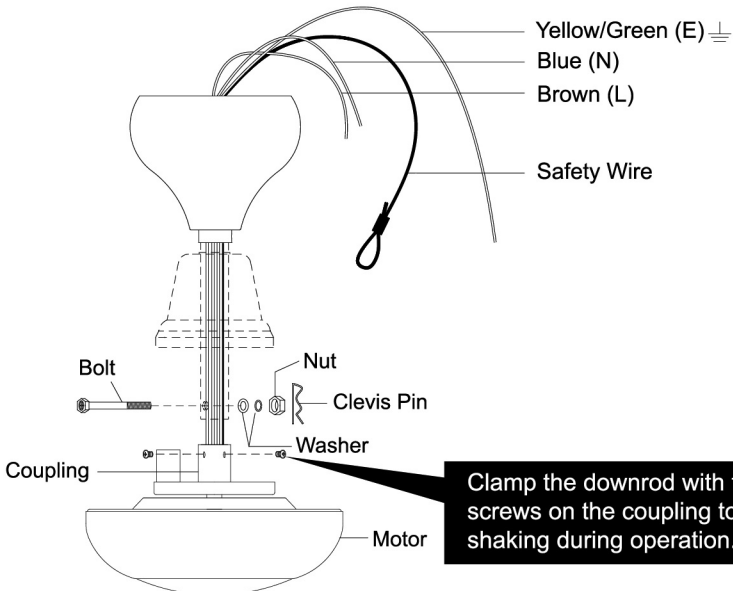
IMPORTANT : SWITCH OFF THE ELECTRICAL MAINS AT THE CIRCUIT BREAKER FUSE BOX.

Step 1 - Assemble the canopy and coupling cover through the downrod.



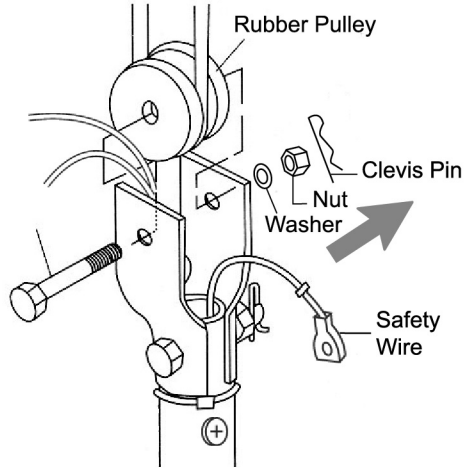
Step 2 - Route the all the wires from the motor through the downrod. Fix the downrod to the coupling with bolt, washer, nut and tighten them firmly then insert the clevis pin.

IMPORTANT : Clevis pin MUST be inserted to prevent nut from loosening.

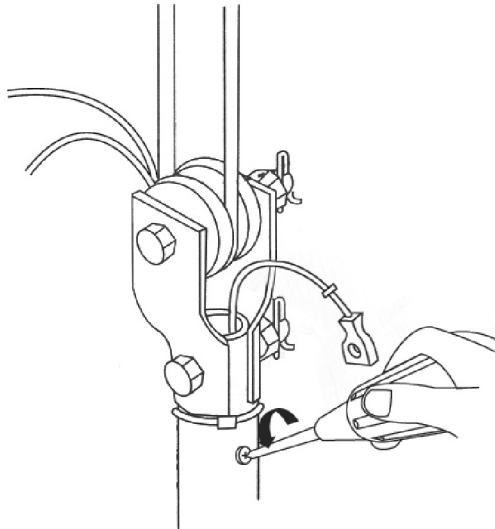

Step 3 - Remove the bolt, clevis, nut, washer and rubber pulley from the downrod.
Place the rubber pulley onto the ceiling hook and fix back the bolt, clevis, nut and washer.
IMPORTANT : Clevis pin **MUST** be inserted to prevent nut from loosening.

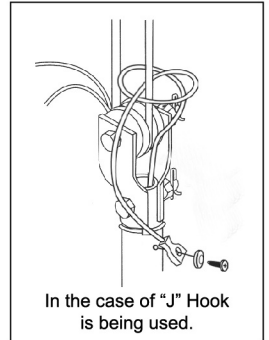
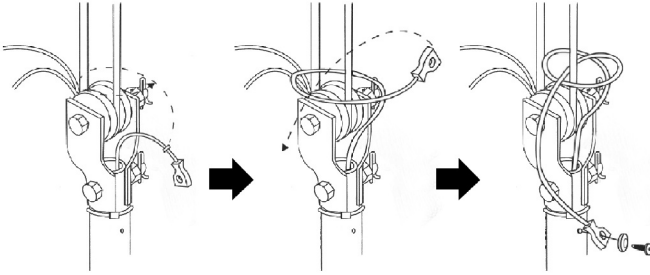


Step 4 - Remove the safety wire screw and spring washer from the downrod.
IMPORTANT : Clevis pin **MUST** be inserted to prevent nut from loosening.

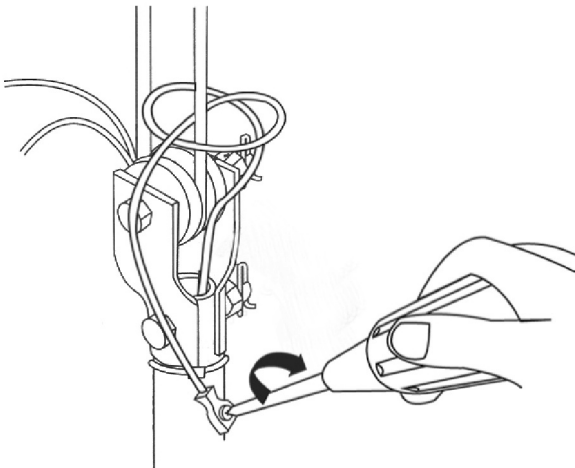

Step 5 - Tie the safety wire across the hook as shown.

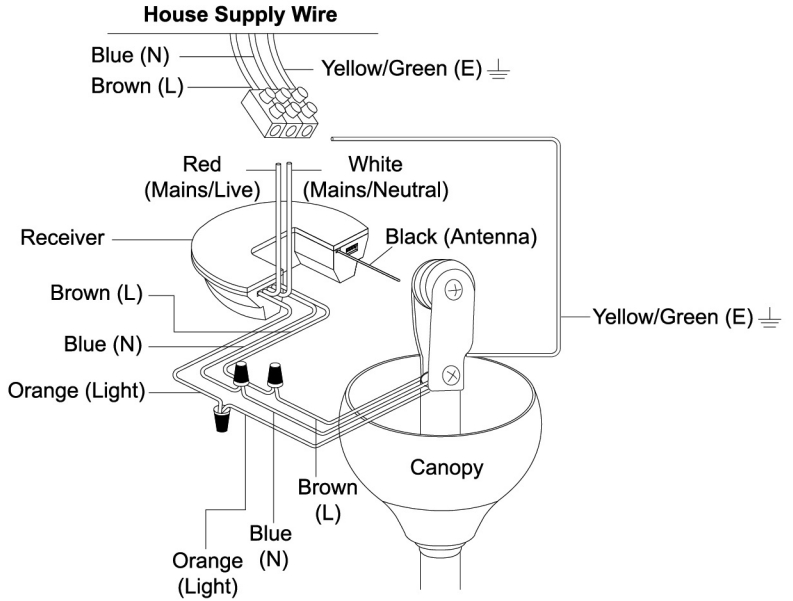


Step 6 - Firmly screw the safety wire with spring washer onto the downrod.

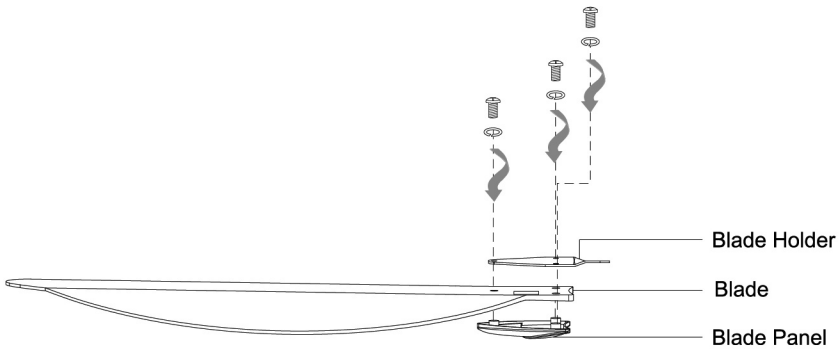

Step 7 - Connect the brown, blue and orange wires from the receiver to the fan. Connect the red, white and green wires to the house's supply wire.



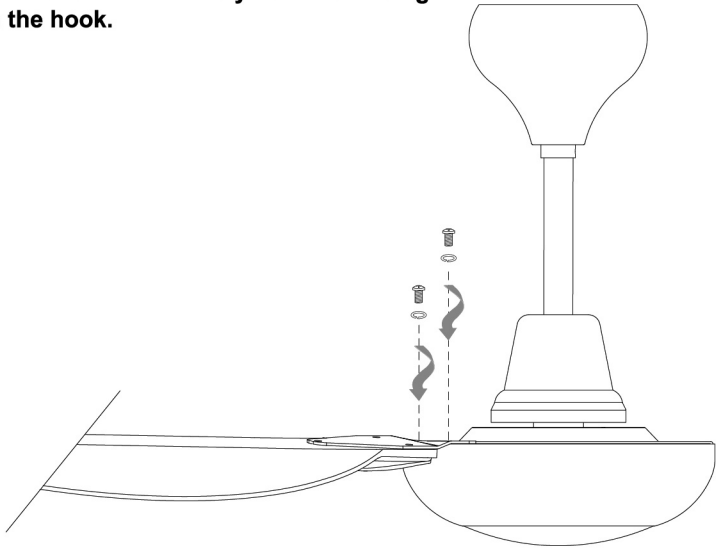
Step 8 - Align the 3 holes on the blade holder, blade and blade panel and screw on with the screws and washers provided.

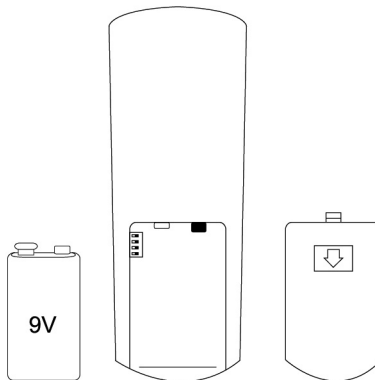
Step 9 - Remove the screws at the motor and fix the blade to the motor using these screws.

IMPORTANT : Assemble the blades only after the ceiling fan is mounted on the hook.



Transmitter Assembly & Operation

Insert the 9V battery (provided) into the transmitter.



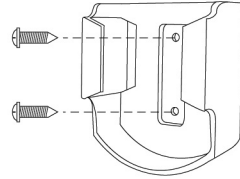
Transmitter Assembly & Operation

Function of Transmitter

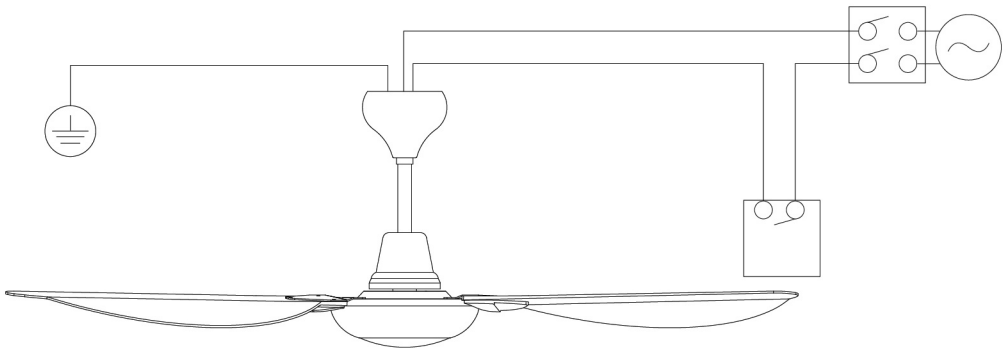
- OFF - Turns off the fan
- 1 - Low speed
- 2 - Medium speed
- 3 - High speed
- 4 - Highest speed
- ON - Turn on light kit (if any)
- OFF - Turn off light kit (if any)



Mount the remote control holder on the wall with screws provided.

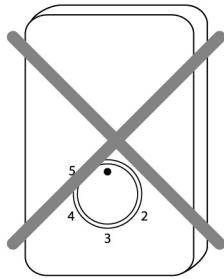


Power Supply Connection

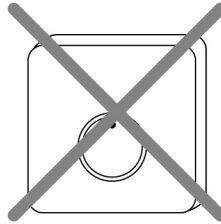


Power Supply Connection

IMPORTANT : DO NOT CONNECT THIS REMOTE CONTROL CEILING FAN TO REGULATOR OR DIMMER SWITCH.

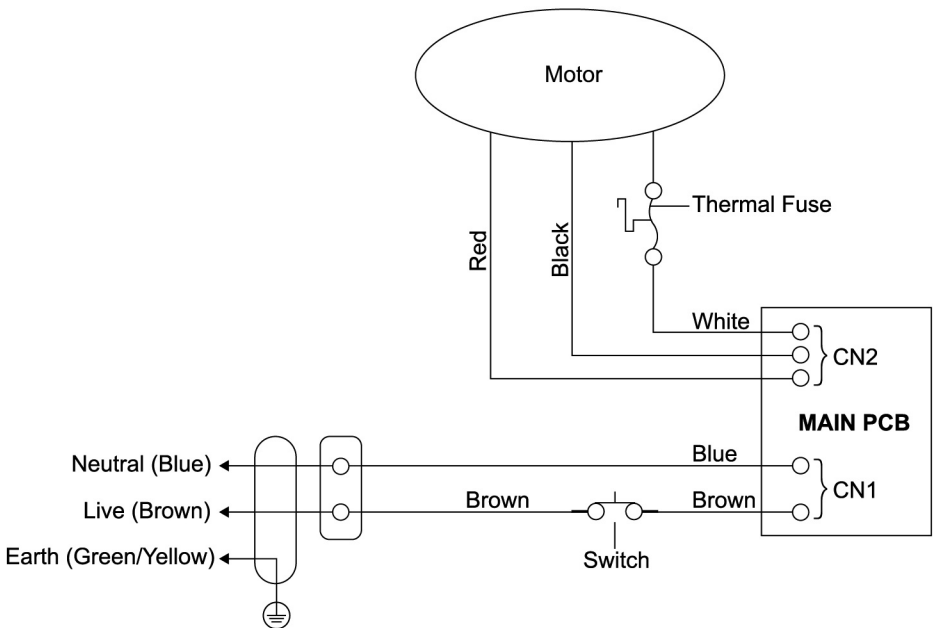


Regulator

Maintenance

Due to the fan's natural movement, connections may get loose after a period of usage. To ensure a proper and safety usage, it is highly recommended to inspect and tighten all connections every 6 months.

Cleaning

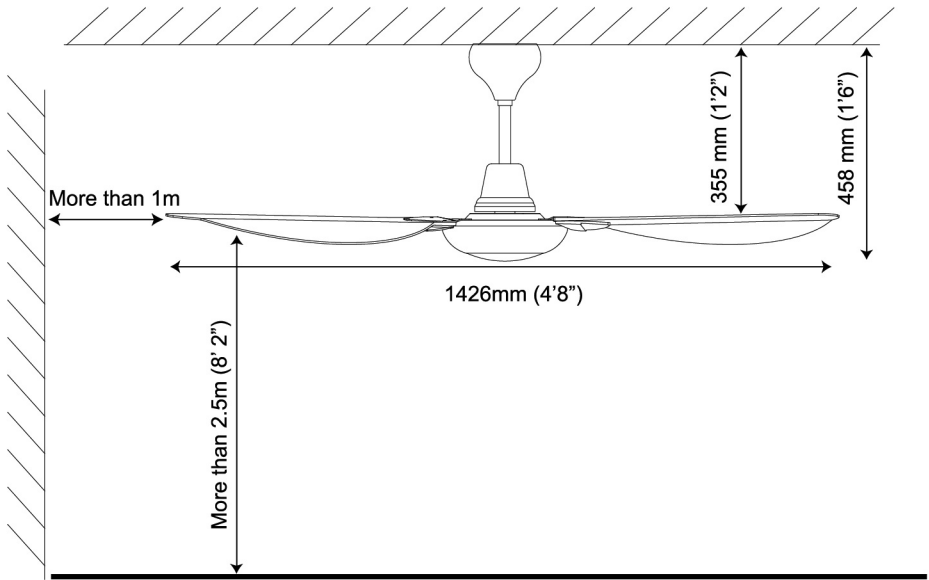
Cleaning your fan periodically will prolong its new appearance. Basic cleaning procedures are as follows :

1. Use only water and mild soap. Do not use solvents, corrosive or acidic solution.
2. Damp the cloth lightly. Use only soft or lint-free cloth to clean the fan. Rough fabric will scratch the surface.
3. Do not bent the blades while cleaning. At the event where blades are bent or damage, order new set of blades from service center or dealer shop.
4. There is no need to oil the fan.
