DAY 1

KUALA LUMPUR / ISTANBUL

Meals: (Meal on Board)

Assemble at Kuala Lumpur International Airport for your departure flight to Istanbul, Turkey.

DAY 2

ISTANBUL/CANAKKALE (320KM)

Meals: (-/L/D) Hotel: 4*Canakkale Iris Hotel or Similar Class

Arrival to Istanbul, where Europe meets Asia. Istanbul is the magical city gateway to Aegean and Mediterranean Coast, the land of fascinating history and beauty.

ISTANBUL CITY WALLS - It boasts several impressive castles a fortification. Massive walls of ancient Constantinople, built by the Emperor Theodosius II over 1500 years ago (Drive Pass)

BLUE MOSQUE (SULTAN AHMET MOSQUE) - The only mosque with six minarets in the world and famous for its magnificent interior paneling.

HIPPODROME SQUARE - The former center of sportive and political Activities.

ST. SOPHIA MUSEUM - Which have been a cathedral and a mosque, now is a magnificent museum.

UNDERGROUND WATER CISTERN (BASILICA CISTERN) - Built between the 3rd and 4th centuries during the Early Roman Age, is supported by a forest of 336 marble columns.

Depart to Canakkale via Gallipoli Peninsula, Crossing the Dardanelles' straits by ferry to Canakkale.

DAY 3

CANAKKALE / BERGAMA / KUSADASI

Meals: (B/L/D) Hotel: 4*Kusadasi Palmin or Similar Class

TROY ANCIENT CITY & TROY WOODEN HORSE - Where Greek and Trojan heroes fought the "Trojan War" for the honour of the beautiful Helen.

BERGAMA TOWN CENTER - Bergama Acropolis is an architecture masterpiece that is perched on the city's highest point.

There will be a stop at natural leather shop with fashion show and aged jewellery.

DAY 4

KUSADASI/PAMUKKALE (200KM)

Meals: (B/L/D) Hotel: 4*Pamukkale Hierapark Thermal Hotel or Similar Class

HOUSE OF VIRGIN MARY - Some people believed that Virgin Mary lived here with St John towards the end of her life.

EPHESUS - One of the most important archaeological site in the modern world of civilization. Some outstanding structures included are the library of Celsus, the Amphitheatre, Hadrian Temple, marble street.

COTTON CASTLE - Where calcareous thermal springs descending over cliffs have created fascinating travertine in the form of white terraces and basins.

DAY 5

PAMUKKALE / KONYA (400KM) / CAPPADOCIA (260KM)

Hotel: 5*Cappadocia Best Western Premier Hotel or Similar Class

KONYA SELJUK CARAVANSERAJ - Which was built in 1299. Is a place where ancient merchants and travellers from Pamukkale to Cappadocia must pass. Konya was the center of the Seljuk empire as well as the city centre of the Mevlana museum.

Continue to **CAPPADOCIA**. The land of ancient volcanic and underground cities.

DAY 6

CAPPADOCIA

Meals: (B/L/D)

Hotel: 5*Cappadocia Best Western Premier Hotel or Similar Class

Hot air ballooning over the charming landscape during sunrise is optional this morning time.

Get the rare chance to experience the beauty and work of Turkey's handmade crafts through a **TURKISH CARPET WEAVING COURSE**.

Visit to the **PIGEON VALLEY** and the fascinating frescoed rock churches.

UCHISAR "CASTLE" - A fantasy-land of strange and wonderful works of man and nature. (Photo stop)

Proceed to **AVANOS POTTERY VILLAGE** and have chance to view Turkish semi-precious **TURKISH TURQUOISE**.

UNDERGROUND CITY - A place of refuge for 15000 Christians. Witness the ancient bedrooms, church, meeting hall and food storage rooms in this eight-storey city connected by 30km of corridors and passageways.

CAVUSIN CHURCH - One of the oldest churches in Cappadocia.

Dinner and enjoy your fascinating **BELLY DANCE SHOW**.

DAY 7

CAPPADOCIA / ANKARA (308KM) / BOLU (200 KM)

Meals: (B/L/D)

Hotel: 4*Bolu Kar Palace Hotel or Similar Class

SALT LAKE - The second largest lake in Turkey. Because the algae infects, the lake will turn bright red colour.

ATATURK MAUSOLEUM - The final resting place of Mustafa Kemal Ataturk - the father of modern Turkey. The architecture of the mausoleum is a mix of different styles that represent the various Anatolian civilizations.

DAY 8

BOLU / ISTANBUL

Meals: (B/L/D)

Hotel: 4*Istanbul Ramada Encore or Similar Class

BOSPHORUS CRUISE - Enjoy the unique experience of cruising between the two continents of Asia and Europe.

TOPKAPI PALACE - The former imperial residence from where the great Ottoman Empire once ruled. Today it is a spectacular museum that has collections of Chinese porcelains and imperial treasury included the world's biggest emeralds and diamonds!
