Moscow City Tour

The Grand Kremlin Palace – Is the historical, spiritual and political heart of Moscow, where to visit some of the site: Assumption Cathedral, Cathedral of the Annunciation, Tsar Bell and Tsar Cannon.

Red Square – Earned its name from the Russian word "red" also meant "beautiful".

St. Basil's Cathedral – Wonderfully ornamented of onion domes design.

The GUM Department Store – Free time for shopping experience.

The Moscow Metro – It was tunneled and built mainly by forced laborers and was finally and ceremoniously inaugurated on 15 May 1935.

DAY 3

MOSCOW - SERGIEV POSAD

Meals: (B / L / D)

Sergiev Posad – Is often called Russian Vatican. In XIV century, Saint Sergius Radaonezhsky founded one of the biggest and most famous Russian Monasteries – The Trinity Monasteries of St. Sergius.

Trinity Cathedral – It is the most famous Andrew Rublev's icon.

DAY 4

MOSCOW - MURMANSK

Meals: (B / L / D)

Cathedral of Christ the Savior (Drive Pass) – Visible from all over central Moscow and is the largest church in Russia.

Victory Square – Is the Russian People during World War II Great Patriotic War Memorial in the hand of their prayer form peace.

Arc de Triomphe – Built in 1829.

Observation Platform of Gorky Park and Sparrow Hills – The largest point in Moscow for panoramic view of city.

Moscow State University – Observe the famous university with Stalinist architectural style.

Depart to Murmansk, the world's largest city in Arctic Circle.

DAY 5

MURMANSK

Meals: (B / L / D)

Murmansk – Located in the extreme northwest part of Russia, on the Kola Bay, close to Russia's borders with Norway and Finland.

Sami of Russian Lapland – Live in a way of life which has not changed over the last century.

Take a ride on a sledge pulled by reindeers as well as snowmobiling (2 on a sledge / snowmobile). Tonight you will be able to marvel the amazing Northern Light.

DAY 6

MURMANSK

Meals: (B / L / D)

Murmansk State Museum – Introduce the nature and history of Murmansk and the hero city of Murmansk in World War II. It is also the largest museum in the Arctic Circle.

Lenin Nuclear Icebreaker – The world's first surface ship utilizing nuclear power and today serves as a museum to preserve the history of the pioneering craft. (close on Monday & Tuesday)

Alyoha Monument – The 35.5m high of the statue is a soldier in a greatcoat with a rifle slung over his shoulder.

After dinner, you will have a second hunting for Northern Lights and return at midnight.

DAY 7

MURMANSK - ST. PETERSBURG

Meals: (B/L/D)

Peter and Paul's Fortress – Which was constructed during the reign of Peter the Great.

An excursion to Peterhof for a visit to the Grand Palace.

The favorite summer residence of the Russian emperor Peter the Great. Peterhof constitutes a grandiose 18th-19th century architecture, fountain (closed in winter) and park ensemble with an area of over a thousand hectares.

The Great Cascades – Its unique array of fountains is considered to be one of the most beautiful in the world.

DAY 8

ST. PETERSBURG

Meals: (B / L / D)

Winter Palace – Formerly the residence of czars. It is now home of the world famous Hermitage Museum with celebrated works by Rembrandt, Leonardo da Vinci, and major French impressionists.

Palace Square – The central city square of St. Petersburg is marked with the Alexander Column (1830-34) is 47.5 meters high and weighs 500 tons.

St. Isaac's Cathedral – situated on St. Isaac's square and is the largest and most ornate church. This cathedral built in 19th century by a French architect is decorated with real marble slabs inside and features a gold leafed dome

DAY 9

ST. PETERSBURG - KUALA LUMPUR

Transfer to Pulkov Airport for your departure flight to Kuala Lumpur.
