

PROTECTION FOR YOUR HANDS

During fluoroscopy procedures, Radiologists may receive some of the highest doses of radiation of any medical personal. Chronic irradiation of the hands is a principle concern.

NIOSH: *The National Institute for Occupational Safety and Health guidelines state that No Part of the body should be directly exposed to radiation. If there is a danger of exposing a body part, that Appropriate Protection must be used.*

Shield hands from the harmful effects of exposure by using a full 360 degree protection as shown below.



Hand Guard Radiation Protective Gloves

Five fingered protection for full dexterity. 0.5mm Pb equivalency dip molded core. Durable, soft navy vinyl covering. 15"
