One bait (4 gram) packs enough active ingredient to kill one rat.

Suitable for 'pulse' baiting

Apply STORM® in 'pulses'. Most rats would have eaten the bait in the first pulse or application round. Wait for about 7 days for STORM® to act before applying the second pulse for rats missed in the first pulse.

Convenient block size

The blue block (4 gram) is easy to use and place. Its blue color makes it easily identified among leaf litter and loose fruits. It formulation is also resistant to mould, insects and moisture.

Good palatability to rats

STORM® is made of high-quality crushed grain and palatable to rats.

Contains human taste deterrent

STORM® contains a bitter taste to reduce accidental poisoning especially among young children.

STORM® Formulation

STORM® ready-to-use bait is available as a grain-based formulation containing 50ppm (0.005%) flocoumafen. The principal commercial formulation is the wax bound block.

Directions for use

Oil Palm: Place one bait at the base of each palm when the monthly census show more than 5% fresh fruit damage. Replace all baits taken weekly until bait replacement is brought down to 20%.

Cocoa: Commence baiting when rat damage exceed 50 pods/ ha. Place one bait at base of every 5th tree and replace all bait taken weekly until bait replacement is brought down to 20%.


Paddy: Place one bait every 10 to 15 m on bund and in front of burrows, before sowing or transplanting, followup baiting should be done two weeks after sowing or transplanting and subsequently replace baits taken weekly until bait replacement is brought down to 20%.
