

SECTION 6 – HEALTH HAZARDS

Route(s) of entry	Inhalation YES	Skin YES	Ingestion YES	Eyes YES	
Effects of over exposure		Corrosive to skin, eyes and mucous membranes, digestive tract.			
Inhalation:	Irritation of respiratory system / mists can cause damage to respiratory passages.				
Skin contact	Causes burning and possible deep ulceration				
Ingestion :	Gastric distress (severe damage to membranes and deep tissues)				
Eyes :	Will cause burning and severe damage even blindness rapidly.				

EMERGENCY AND FIRST AID PROCEDURES

Eyes and Skin	Flush eyes with plenty of water for 15 minutes. GET IMMEDIATE MEDICAL ATTENTION. Use vinegar to neutralize skin then wash well with soap and water. Get medical help if irritation persist.
Ingestion	Do not induce vomiting. GET IMMEDIATE MEDICAL ATTENTION. CALL POISON CONTROL CENTER.
Inhalation	Remove to fresh air, if breathing is difficult or stops then start artificial respiration. GET MEDICAL ATTENTION.

Step to be taken in case container is punctured and material is released.	
Small spills	Neutralize with dilute acid and flush with water to drain.
Large spills	Due to packaging, large spills can not occur.
Waste Disposal Method	Deposits in local land fill in accordance with local, state and federal regulations.
