Mounting, installation and adjustment

ACAUTION


Do not use the product so as to apply load when pulling the piston rod.

Because the cylinder built-in spring has only returning force for the piston rod, the rod cannot be returned to the stroke end when a load is applied.

Do not leave the single acting cylinder pressurized. If it is left pressurized for long periods, the piston rod may not return due to spring load when the pressure is released.

For the single acting cylinder, take care when mounting so as not to block the breathing hole provided on the cover surface. Otherwise, malfunctions may result.

- When using CAT-N (panel mounting), only use the attached clamping nipple (FCS6-M5-P; orifice size φ0.8 mm). Otherwise, malfunctions or body damage may result.
- For applicable clamping tube, our model No. F-1506 (outer diameter 6 mm, inner diameter 4 mm) is recommended.
- When using CAT-O (inset), make sure that the washer sealing portion does not make contact with the square tang for wrench application. Failure to do so may lead to air leakage.



Use/maintenance

Because this cylinder is a non-disassembly type, do not apply excessive force to the rod cover or body.
