#### **SUBSTRATE QUALITY / PRE-TREATMENT**

The concrete must be clean, sound and free of all loose and friable material, cement laitance, oil and grease, etc. Absorbent surfaces should be saturated

thoroughly with clean water.

#### **APPLICATION METHOD / TOOLS**

Add SikaLatex®-88 directly to fresh cement to create a soft creamy bonding agent.

To improve renders, plasters, repair materials, tiling adhesives, etc. add SikaLatex®-88 directly to the mix.

- Never use neat SikaLatex®-88 as a bonding agent always add cement and sand.
