## ATHENS

- **Panathenaic Stadium** - Where the first modern Olympic Games were held in 1896.
- **Temple of Olympian Zeus** - Also known as the Olympieion or Columns of the Olympian Zeus, is a former colossal temple at the center of the Greece capital Athens.
- **The Monument of Unknown Soldier** - It is a monument in central Baghdad built by Italian architect, Marcello D'Olivo, based on a concept by Iraqi sculptor, Khaled al-Rahal, and constructed between 1979 and 1982. It was dedicated to the martyrs of the Iran-Iraq War.
- **Acropolis** - The Classical Period or Golden Age of Greece, from around 500 to 300 BC, has given the great monuments, art, philosophy, architecture, and literature which are the building blocks of our own civilization. In the following era, as thought and art flourished, the rocky hill has been transformed into a unique monument of thought and the arts. The most important monuments which are the Parthenon, the Erechtheion, the Propylaea, and the small temple Athena Nike were built during that time.

## SANTORINI ISLAND

- **Santorini** - An island in the southern Aegean Sea, about 200km (120 mi) southeast of Greece's mainland. It is the largest island of a small, circular archipelago, which bears the same name and is the remnant of a volcanic caldera. The municipality of Santorini includes the inhabited islands of Santorini and Therasia and the uninhabited islands of Nea Kameni, Palaia Kameni, Aspronisi, and Christiana.
- **Perrisa Black Sand Beach** - Located on the rim of the volcano, the various beaches, its clear that there was a history of volcanic activity.
- **Fira Town** - It is the capital of Santorini. Modern day, Fira is the cultural and commercial center of the Santorini.

- **Mykonos Little Venice** - One of the most romantic places in the whole of Mykonos. This neighborhood is replete with elegant and gorgeous old houses that are situated precariously on the edge of the sea. Quite amazing are the sunset views from Little Venice. Its whitewashed edifices against the backdrop of the azure blue Aegean Sea is simply marvelous. Walk through “Matogiania” will be memorable for your vacations.
- **Mykonos Windmills** - Iconic features of the Greek island of the Mykonos. The island is one of the Cyclades islands, which neighbor Delos in the Aegean Sea. Windmills are the first thing seen when coming into the harbor of Alefkandra, as they stand on a hill overlooking the area.
- **Mykonos Paraportiani** - A lovely church of Panagia (Virgin Mary). It is among the most photographed churches not only in Mykonos but in the whole world.
