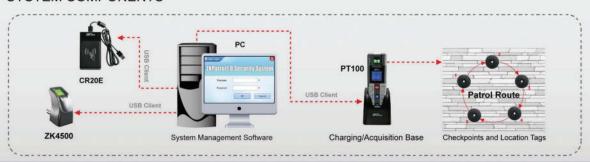
FINGERPRINT PATROL SYSTEM

Embedded with fingerprint authentication technology, PT100 provides a means to record exactly who, when and where the employee reaches certain important points on their tour. Checkpoints or watchstations are represented by location tags which are commonly placed at the extreme ends of the tour route and at critical points such as vaults, specimen refrigerators, vital equipment, access points, etc.

The PT100 has a LCD display used for patrol guidance and event reporting which would offer a better user experience and save the cost and inconvenience caused by ordinary incident recording facility, "Event Wallet".

Besides, the systems could set the interval between stations to be timed period so it will show in the reports if the employee fails to reach each point within a set time.
